5,600 kilometers from Afghanistan to Europe.

A refugee family in search of a safe haven documents their own journey using just three smartphones — an unprecedented self-filmed documentary!

In 2015, filmmaker Hassan Fazili was sentenced to death by the Taliban. After his documentary about peace in Afghanistan aired on national television, the Taliban were enraged by its content and killed the man who appeared in it. Danger was closing in on Hassan as well. To protect his family, he decided to set out with his wife and two daughters on a 5,600-kilometer journey from Afghanistan to Europe.
